> 3. Writing, submitting, revising, publishing and reviewing scientific papers – what is expected of you? 4. Writing papers in English – suggestions, avoiding common mistakes, encouragement; 5.

Good scientific practice – plagiarism and other pitfalls.

Two lecture blocks: each day from 9:00 to 12:00 and from 13:30 to 16:00. **Format** 

Grading To be certified, the participants are supposed to attend all lectures and write a short abstract (250

> words) using some of the methods and writing techniques discussed and practiced during the course. A deadline for submitting the abstract several weeks after the end of the course will be

decided with the students on the first day of the course. Credit points: 3 CP

solid command of the English language is expected. This is not an English course! Also it is not required, but it is better if the participants bring their own laptops!
