**In November, the KSE Foundation reported on its work in 2022, restored the Makariv outpatient clinic and repaired shelters in schools, distributed Ukrainian books abroad, and gave grants to talented youth.**

On November 20, a meeting of friends, partners, and donors of the foundation was held, where we reported on the year of work, held an auction, and raised more than \$2,600,000 for the development of education and assistance for the Ukrainian army.

The project to rebuild the Makariv outpatient clinic has crossed the equator: the building has walls, windows, and a roof. At the beginning of next year, the institution will be able to receive its first patients!

By the end of November, we received 124 applications for participation in the Safe Education campaign. The campaign is expanding: initially, we planned to repair 100 shelters, but feeling your support, we raised the goal to 300 institutions. Four shelters have already been completed, and eight more are being restored.

Friends of KSE Foundation from Raiffeisen Bank have provided €1,000,000, which we will use to equip shelters in 100 schools across Ukraine! Another of our partners, FUIB Bank, has fully covered the costs of repairing shelters in two educational institutions.

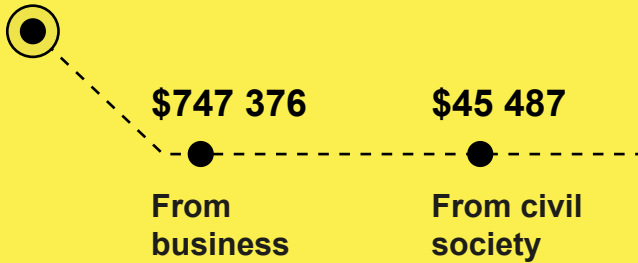
Our projects to distribute books in Ukrainian abroad (plus seven countries) and provide grants to talented youth are also ongoing.
