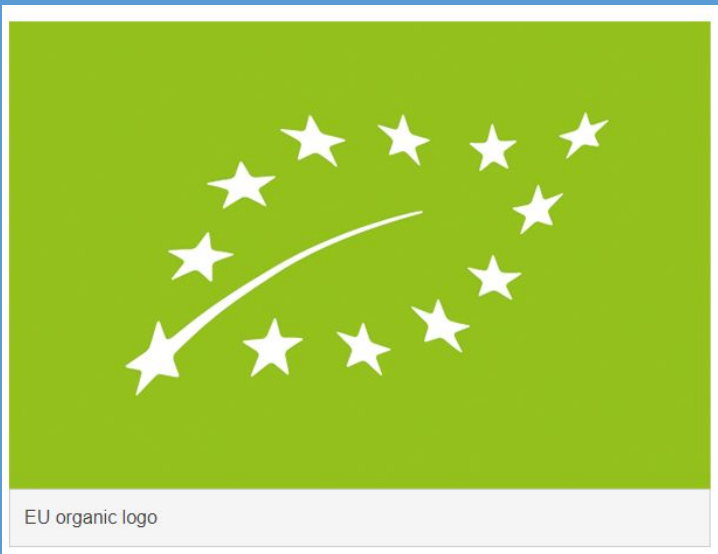

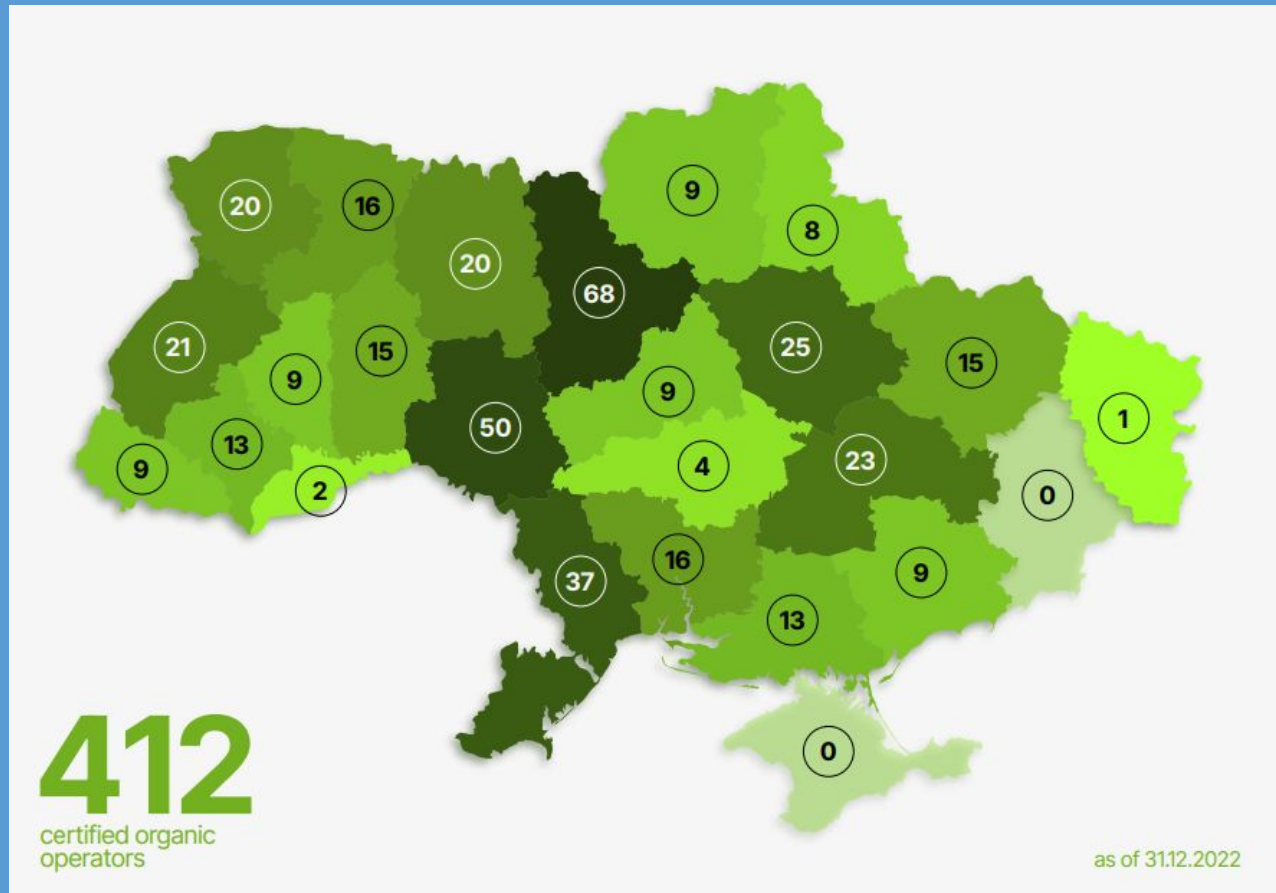

Organic farming in Ukraine – Certified according to EU-organic regulation



Regulation (EU) 2018/848 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 on organic production of agricultural products.



31.12.2022: 412 organic operators (2021: 528 organic operators) - 78 %

31.12.2022: 260.000 ha (2021: 420.000 ha) – 62 %

Organic farming in Ukraine – Certified according to Ukrainian organic regulation



Certification possible since August 2023. 100 companies have already been certified so far.

On Basic Principles and Requirements for Organic Production, Circulation and Labelling of Organic Products

(The Official Bulletin of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine (BVR), 2018, No. 36, Article 275)

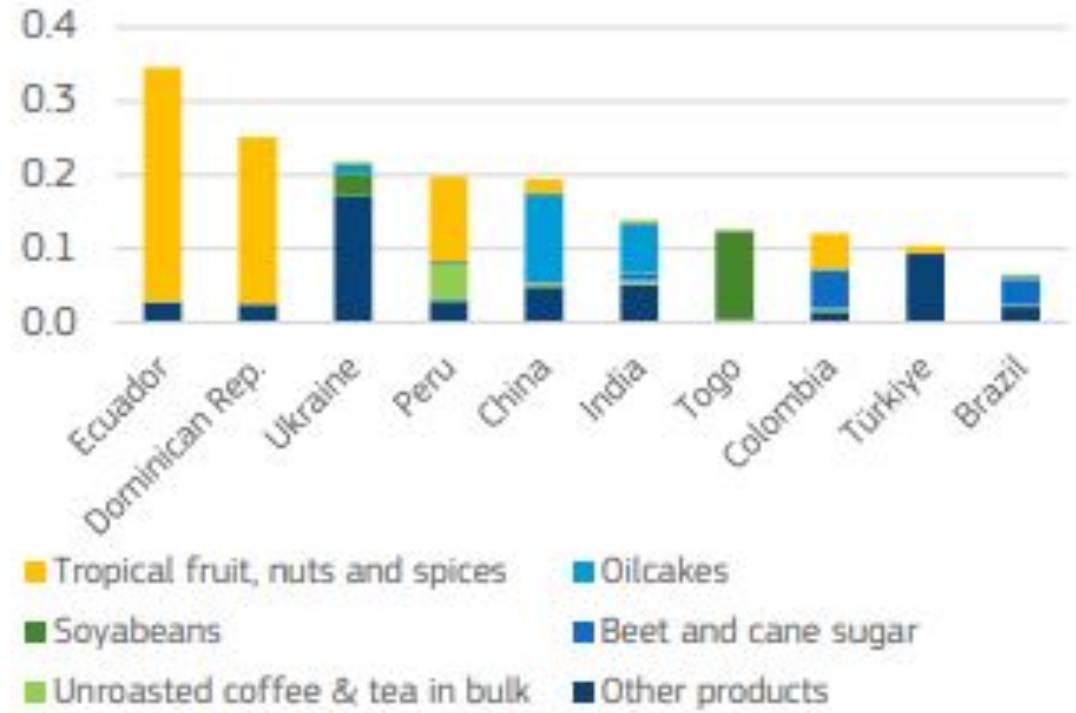
{As amended under Law
No. 2740-VIII of 06.06.2019, BVR, 2019, No. 28, Article 116}

This Law defines core principles and requirements for organic production, circulation and labelling of organic products, principles of legal regulation of organic production, circulation of organic products and functioning of the organic product market, legal fundamentals in the activity of central executive authorities, organic market entities and state policy in these areas.

GRAPH 5 – Main product categories of organic agri-food imports by exporting country, 2022 (million t)

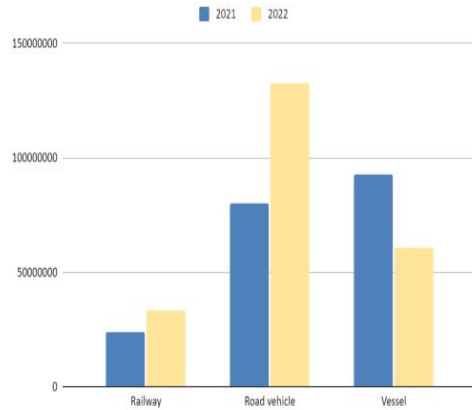

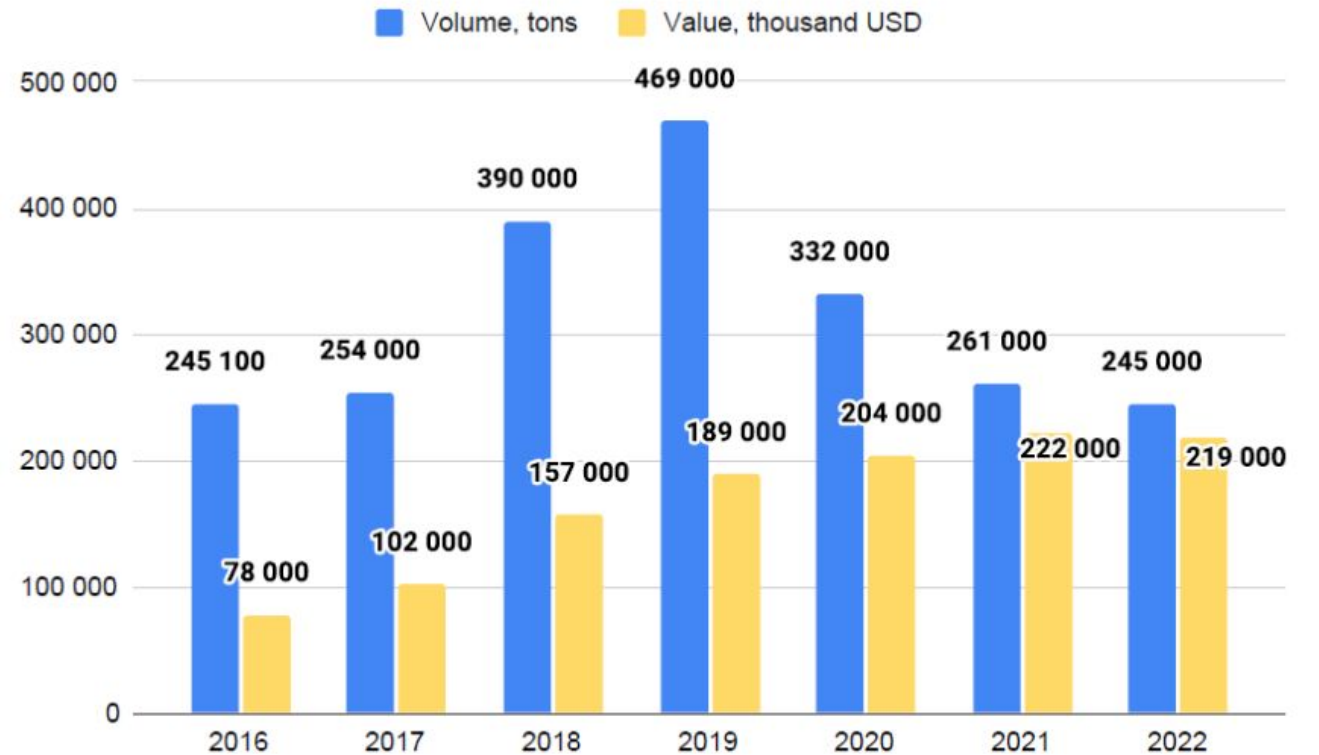
